

City of Jetmore Municipal Wind Project



Shown above is the final installation of the first Municipal Wind Generation Project in the State of Kansas. In March, 2009, both turbines were in production. These turbines are refurbished Micon 108's...retired from California and refurbished by West Wind Energy, LLC out of Otis, KS. The City has installed 2 turbines and what is unique about this project is that no power is sold elsewhere...it feeds directly into the City's grid and helps to keep the cost of electricity down for all of the citizens in the community! We are watching the numbers closely this year, and so far, they are producing as projected. They pay-off period for the City is between 7 and 9 years, depending on average annual wind speeds and current energy costs.
